Analysis: S2 civil record of marriage identifies Mary's surname as Delven and John's as Field, while S3 Copy of Sacramental Record identifies Mary's surname as Devlin and John's as Fields. The town clerk for the civil record appears to have recorded several marriages performed by Rev. Geo. F. Haskins at one time, sometime after 5 May 1850. The church records are more likely to have been recorded closer to the date of marriage by the priest performing the marriage who would have likely known the correct names of the parties.

Conclusion: There is a conflict with the surnames. The civil marriage record shows Field and Delven, but the sacramental marriage record and the death certificate show Fields and Devlin. Based on the above evidence, I conclude that Mary Jane's parents are John Fields and Mary Devlin.
