- William H. Cody married her grandmother, Ethel A. Emery
- William and Ethel were living in the San Diego area at the time of the birth of their daughter, Arlene, in 1933
- Other family trees on *Ancestry* attributed William's paternal parent as John McCoy, married to Sara/Sarah J. Allred, and living in Tennessee in 1900.

No evidence sources were provided by the client and will require verification as part of this project.

Objective: Identify the father of William H. Cody, husband of Ethel A. Emery and father of Arlene Cody, who lived in San Diego County, California, about 1933.

Limitations: Ten hours (pro bono) for research and report writing. Due to current COVID restrictions, record access at this time is limited to online repositories.

Summary of Findings

Father of William H. Cody

The father of William H. Cody is likely William T. Cody, born 13 March 1871 and died 18 October 1895, buried in Leach Cemetery in Rocky Top, Anderson County, Tennessee.¹ The following evidence supports this father-son relationship:

- The California Death Index entry for William H. Cody lists his birth as 13 February 1895 in Tennessee, and the surnames of his parents as Cody (father) and Allred (mother's maiden).²
- In 1942, William Harry Cody listed his birth date as 13 February 1895 and birth location as "Coalcreek, Tennessee."³ The town of Coal Creek, which straddles the Anderson/Campbell

County line, has undergone two name changes since its founding in 1856: first to Lake City in 1936, then to Rocky Top in 2014.⁴

- In the 1930 census, William H. Cody's parents are listed as born in Tennessee.⁵
- At the time of his 1923 marriage in Los Angeles County to Ethel A. Emery, William H. Cody named his father as William Cody and his mother as Sarah Allred.⁶
- On 24 December 1889, William Cody and Sarah Alred were married in Anderson County, Tennessee, prior to William H. Cody's birth in 1895.⁷
- William T. Cody died on 18 October 1895 and was buried in current-day Rocky Top, Anderson County, approximately 8 months after William H. Cody's birth in the same town.⁸

William T. Cody

William T. Cody's life predated state and county registration in Tennessee.⁹ His gravestone in Leach Cemetery records his birth as 13 March 1871 and death as 18 October 1895 and notes his mother as Nancy Cody.¹⁰ In 1880, Nancy Cody lived with her two sons and one daughter in Careyville, approximately seven miles northwest of Coal Creek. The youngest son, "W.R. Cody," was born about 1871-72 in Tennessee.¹¹ His two siblings, J[ames] E. and R[osennie] E. Cody, are buried in the same section of Leach Cemetery as William T. Cody.¹² While extant online records for William T. Cody are scant, the 1880 census and his siblings' proximity in Leach Cemetery provide evidence of William's presence in the area and make him a likely candidate for Sarah Alred's husband and William H. Cody's father.

Attribution of John McCoy as William H. Cody's Father

As of 22 February 2021, five public trees on Ancestry record William H. Cody's father as John McCoy. An additional fifteen public trees provide William's name as Willie McCoy, son of John McCoy. The reason for this confusion is easily identified. William was a young child when his widowed mother, Sarah June

Cody, married John McCoy on 21 November 1895 in neighboring Union County, just over a month after her first husband's death.¹³ In 1900 and 1910, William is living in the John McCoy household as "Willie McCoy."¹⁴ William was not listed as a stepchild to John McCoy, but it is likely that the distinction was not made to the enumerator by the informant. William's age on both census records correlate and provide evidence that William was born the same year as his mother's marriage to John McCoy in 1895.

Analysis: Evidence correlates with information provided by client for family names, location, and Arlene's birth in 1933. Ethel served as informant, marked with an "X."¹⁶ Based on William's given age and the census enumeration date of 1 April 1940, his birth was likely between 2 April 1894 and 1 April 1895 in Tennessee. The 1940 census did not note birth locations for an individual's parents.

Analysis: Informant is undetermined. Age regression for William and Ethel from the 1940 census aligns with this census. Based on William's given age and the census enumeration date of 1 April 1930, William's birth was likely between 2 April 1894 and 1 April 1895 in Tennessee, correlating with the 1940 census. Tennessee is noted as the birthplace of William's parents, providing additional evidence for identification of his father. Both William and Ethel's age at first marriage indicates they were wed about 1922 (location unknown).

Analysis: William's birth date and address correlates with both the 1930 and 1940 census records in San Diego. His place of birth is more precisely reported as Coalcreek, Tennessee. The person listed as knowing William's address is Homer McCoy. The surname of this contact correlates with the name reported by the client as found in multiple Ancestry family trees as William's possible father, John McCoy.

Analysis: The index is considered a derivative record; it is recommended that the original death certificate be ordered to validate the transcription. The informant is not identified and cannot be evaluated as to the accuracy of the information provided. The index reports only surnames for William's parents: his mother's maiden name (Allred) and father's surname (Cody). The original death certificate may contain full names for his parents. William's birth date of 13 February 1895 and birthplace of Tennessee correlates with information found in the 1930 and 1940 censuses, as well as the 1942 draft registration card. William died on 10 October 1945 in San Diego County.

Partial Transcription:

"Hero of one of the most thrilling chapters in the annals of the San Diego police force, the 'Battle of Mission Hills,' in 1927, William H. Cody, 50, of 4156 Ohio st., retired police patrolman, died yesterday of a heart attack in a café near Thirtieth st. and University ave., Deputy Coroner E. A. Turner reported."

Analysis: The obituary states that William suffered a heart attack the previous day, providing direct evidence to his date of death as 10 October 1945. The article makes no mention of his personal history or family relationships, which indicates the event of William's death was treated more as a news item than a traditional obituary announcement. His age was noted as fifty, supporting his date of birth as 13 February 1895. Also, the extensive coverage of his service as a policeman for the city correlates with his occupation on the 1940 census. While the Deputy Coroner served as information for the details of William's death, it is undetermined where he received the information regarding William's age. It is possible it was confirmed by his widow, Ethel, or from his employment records as a police officer. The address of 4156 Ohio Street differs from the previous location of 4841 Kansas Street found on the 1930 and 1940 censuses, implying a move between 1940 and 1945.

Analysis: The age differences for William and Ethel, their birthplaces, and the time frame of the marriage correlate to the 1930 census. William's parent's full names are provided and match the surnames transcribed in the California Death Index. In the 1930 census, William's father was recorded as born in Tennessee. This document, listing his birth in North Carolina, provides evidence supplied by William at the time of his marriage and should not be dismissed out of hand as incorrect. William and Ethel both indicated they resided in San Francisco; this the first time this location has been documented for this couple.

Analysis: The marriage register is a preprinted sheet spanning two pages in book form. Entries found two pages on either side of the record in question are in the same hand, indicating the records were likely transcribed by a clerk after the event. The transcriber did not follow the printed headings for all columns, choosing to note most information in incorrect fields. Many of the records, including William and Sarah's marriage, reflect one date under "Date of Marriage" and a later date in the officiant statement to the right. It's possible that the earlier date of 23 December 1889 noted for William and Sarah was the date the license was issued. The date of William and Sarah's marriage occurs prior to William H. Cody's birth in 1895. Sarah's surname of "Alred" reflects an alternate spelling and phonetically correlates with previous records. The location of Anderson County also correlates to William's stated place of birth. Coal Creek, now known as Rocky Top, straddles the Anderson and Campbell county line in Tennessee.²³

1894-1895 Birth Record – William H. Cody – Tennessee

Tennessee did not require statewide registration of births until 1914, although some counties recorded births as early as 1881.²⁴ Online databases were searched statewide for evidence of William H. Cody's birth with no result.²⁵ A visual search of digitized unindexed Anderson County birth and death records from 1891–1899 produced no evidence of a birth record for William H. Cody.²⁶

1900 U.S. Federal Census search for William Cody, Sarah Cody, William H. Cody

A search of the 1900 U.S. Federal Census in Tennessee and surrounding states for the family unit of William Cody, Sarah Cody, and William H. Cody resulted with no suitable matches.²⁷ A number of family trees on *Ancestry* document John McCoy and Sarah Alred/Allred as the parents of William H. Cody.²⁸ A search for the John McCoy household was conducted in Anderson and surrounding counties in Tennessee.

Analysis: Jellico is located near the Tennessee-Kentucky border in Campbell County, directly north of neighboring Anderson County. “Willie McCoy” is listed in the household of John and Sarah McCoy as a daughter, possibly an enumerator error. The birth date of February 1895 aligns with later records for William H. Cody. John and Sarah’s marriage five years earlier occurred around the same time of Willie’s birth and provides no conclusive answer to John’s biological connection to Willie. John and Sarah’s estimated marriage date of 1895 and the ages of the remaining children infers that Milton and Estel are biological children of John and Sarah, while Etta is likely a child from a previous marriage for either John or Sarah.

Analysis: Knox County lies on the southeast edge of Anderson County. “Willie McCoy” is now listed as a son. The age progression of Willie aligns with the 1900 census from Campbell County. John and Sarah’s estimated marriage in 1895 is correlated as well. The enumerator indicated with “M2” in the marital status column that the marriage of John and Sarah was the second for each. This additional evidence and Willie’s age supports the possibility that Willie may have been a son from a previous marriage for either John or Sarah. In addition, the younger son named “Homar” may be the same Homer McCoy listed on William’s draft registration card in San Diego. More investigation would be required to confirm.

I solemnized the Rites of Matrimony between the above named parties on the **21** day of **Nov**, 1895

Analysis: John and Sarah McCoy's marriage was registered in Union County, a neighboring county to Anderson on its northeast border. Their wedding date in 1895 correlates with evidence of John & Sarah's length of marriage on the 1900 and 1910 census records. The bride's surname of Cody, the second marriage notation from the 1910 census, and the geographic proximity to Anderson County provides strong evidence Sarah Alred and Sarah J. Cody are likely the same person. The marriage of John and Sarah occurred nine months after the reported birth of William H. Cody, providing evidence that John McCoy is likely not "Willie McCoy's" biological father.

1895 Death Records – William Cody – Anderson, Campbell, Knox, and Union Counties, Tennessee

Tennessee did not require statewide registration of deaths until 1914, but some jurisdictions recorded deaths as early as 1881.³² A manual review of an unindexed digitized Anderson County birth and death register from 1891–1899 produced no evidence of a death record for William Cody.³³ A search of death records in Anderson and surrounding counties between 1889–1895 on *FamilySearch* also produced no evidence.³⁴

Analysis: This memorial is the only William Cody listed on *Find A Grave* in Tennessee with a death date between 1889 and 1895. There are eight additional Cody memorials listed in Leach Cemetery. Four are listed as near William T. Cody, possibly a family plot. A memorial for Nancy Cody (referenced on the gravestone) is not found in Leach Cemetery. A neighboring gravestone for Rosennie Cody also lists Nancy Cody as her mother, indicating a potential sibling relationship with William T. Cody. A review of the evidence dates shows that William T. Cody is a likely candidate for William H. Cody's biological father. William T.'s death date of 18 October 1895 occurs after the birth of William H. Cody on 13 February 1895 and prior to the marriage of Sarah J. Cody to John McCoy on 21 November 1895. His birth in 1871 would make him eighteen years old on 24 December 1889 when Sarah Alred married William Cody in Anderson County.

Probate Records – William Cody – Anderson, Campbell, Knox, and Union Counties, Tennessee

Unindexed digitized probate records between 1895 and 1900 for Anderson, Campbell, Knox, and Union counties were manually searched for William Cody. No records were located.³⁶

Analysis: The 1880 household of Nancy Cody in Careyville is approximately seven miles northwest of Coal Creek/Rocky Top. The initials of W.R. Cody do not match William T. Cody, but it is not unusual to find discrepancies for middle initials on census records. His age places his birth from 2 June 1871–1 June 1872, very near the birth date of 13 Mar 1871 on William T. Cody's gravestone. The other siblings in the household match burials in Leach Cemetery for James E. Cody (1865-1892) and Rosennie Cody (1868–1897) in close proximity to William T. Cody.³⁸ As previously noted, Rosennie Cody's gravestone also attributes Nancy Cody as her mother. This additional familial evidence lends significant weight to the conclusion that W.R. Cody is William T. Cody interred in Leach Cemetery. The birth location of Tennessee for W.R. Cody conflicts with a source noted earlier—the location of North Carolina provided by William H. Cody on his 1923 marriage certificate. References within all census records reviewed agree that William H. Cody's father was born in Tennessee. More weight is attributed to the information on this census, as William's mother would have firsthand knowledge of where her son was born. As a secondary informant, it's likely that William H. Cody was incorrect regarding the North Carolina location.

Suggestions for Further Research

- Additional original records may exist to support the identification of William H. Cody's father, but were unobtainable due to the time constraints for this project or archival closures related to the COVID-19 pandemic. It is recommended to pursue obtaining the following original records for additional parent relationship evidence.
 - California Death Certificate for William H. Cody – A copy of this certificate may be obtained directly from San Diego County, or by using the third-party service VitalChek. Information on ordering this record can be found here: [San Diego Death Certificate link](#).
 - Social Security Application for William H. Cody – A copy of the SS-5 application for William Cody may be requested through the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Information on how to request the record can be found here: [SSA FOIA Request link](#). Proof of death will be required to process the request.
 - Burial record for William T. Cody (Leach Cemetery) – As the 1895 death of William T. Cody preceded state-wide registration, a burial record may provide a documented connection to Sarah Allred/Cody/McCoy. Further investigation to identify the entity holding these records will be required.
- Church records in Tennessee may be able to provide information regarding the birth of William H. Cody, as well as the death and burial of William T. Cody. Both of Sarah Allred's marriages were conducted by a Justice of the Peace, and no direct evidence of a religious affiliation for the Cody and McCoy families was located during this project. Further research of churches in the area from 1880–1910 will be required.
- Based on the generational proximity of William H. Cody to the client, autosomal DNA testing may provide DNA matches from collateral Cody line descendants in order to provide additional evidence of William T. Cody's biological connection to the client. For U.S. matches, *Ancestry* currently has the largest database and is the recommended choice for client testing.

William Cody, Once Patrolman, Succumbs at 50

Hero of one of the most thrilling chapters in the annals of the San Diego police force, the "Battle of Mission Hills," in 1927, William H. Cody, 50, of 4156 Ohio st., retired police patrolman, died yesterday of a heart attack in a cafe near Thirtieth st. and University ave. Deputy Coroner E. A. Turner reported.

More than 18 years ago, Mr. Cody first retired from the force for disability incurred when he took part in the shooting of Billy Smith, a Negro, who shot and wounded a maid in the then Showley residence at 1859 Ft. Stockton dr.

Police were called to the scene early in the morning by the report that a woman had been "killed" in the residence. Smith barricaded himself in the house and attempted to shoot it out with police. Mr. Cody and others gained admittance to the home, and when the culprit locked himself in a closet, the officer crossed the room, with bullets from Smith's gun coming through the door, and attempted to open it. He received a bullet wound in the arm. Soon after, the Negro was killed when officers broke down the door.

Mr. Cody was appointed to the police department Jan. 1, 1926, and was first retired on disability in March, 1930. Recalled to active duty, he again was injured in 1935 and retired. He returned to active duty on two more occasions, and was retired both times, the last on May 3, 1945. The body was taken to the Lewis mortuary.
